Ash Wednesday - The Season of Lent Begins

Lent is a holy season of 40 days (plus six Sundays) of preparation leading up to Easter. It is observed as a special time of self examination and penitence. Lent **starts on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017.** As in previous years, we will observe this day together with the people of St. Margaret of Scotland parish. Worship times, including the Imposition of Ashes (for those who wish to participate) and Holy Eucharist will be **10 a.m. in St. Mark’s** (with Rev. Canon Charles Bull preaching), and **7 p.m. in St. Margaret of Scotland** (with Rev. Vivien Hannon preaching). Observing Ash Wednesday is a great way to begin this beautiful time of reflection.
